11,375-5,021-10,549 (# books checked out) X \$20 (average price of book)
= \$ 221,529 Savings to the Community

1,332-289-209 (# of people who used the internet) X \$840 (average cost of internet/year)
= \$ 175,560 Savings to the Community

2,650-983-1,166 (# of other DVDs checked out) X \$14.99 (average price of DVD)
= \$17,478 Savings to the Community
