Open Meeting Policy

The Caledonia Library Association works in accordance with New York State's Open Meeting Law.

All regular monthly meetings of the Caledonia Library are usually held at the Caledonia Library on the last Tuesday of the month at 6:00 p.m. Notice of the time and place of a regularly scheduled meeting is given to the public at least one week in advance. In circumstances where a special meeting takes place, or the regular meeting must be rescheduled, the Caledonia Library Association will follow New York State's Open Meeting Law.

Any person who inquires, in person, or by telephone concerning the date, time, or place shall be so informed, and all meetings are open to the public.

Minutes that have been approved by the board, usually at the next regular meeting, can be viewed on the Library's website: caledonialibrary.org. Minutes that have not been approved by the board will be available for public inspection within two weeks and may be viewed at the Library upon request.
